1. Introductions & Room Parents Introductions (Mo)

Meeting called to order @ 6:36pm. 16 parents & Principal McKinney in attendance. \$74,000 annual fundraising goal. \$985,000 in endowment fund, 4% interest pays for 3 of 6 Classroom Aides. Ultimate goal is \$4 million, which will contribute \$120,000 annually. 2018 fundraising events included commitment sheets (\$40,000), Redwoods Dinner (\$36,000), Read-a-Thon (\$13,000), Sponsorships (\$9,500), Dine Out (\$2,500), Arts Alive (\$4,500), Poker Tournament (\$3,000).
